

Lafayette College Application Instructions

Application

Lafayette College uses only the Common Application, which may be submitted electronically or via traditional mail. The direct link to the Common Application web site is <http://www.commonapp.org/>. If you are completing the paper version of the application, the original may be photocopied and sent to any participating college, including Lafayette. A supplemental form is also required for application to Lafayette. You may find the link to the Common Application website and downloadable versions of the Lafayette Supplement online at: <http://www.lafayette.edu/admissions/> . Other online forms include the Early Decision Agreement form and the International Student Financial Aid application.

An application fee of \$60 is required. This may be paid via check made payable to Lafayette College or money order sent to: Lafayette College Admissions Office, 118 Markle Hall, Lafayette College, Easton, PA 18042. If you are applying online you may pay by credit card or online check from a valid U.S. bank account.

Early Decision

If you would like to apply as an Early Decision candidate, please complete the enclosed Early Decision Agreement form and secure the appropriate signatures from a parent/guardian and guidance counselor. This form should then be returned along with your application or under separate cover.

No early decision applications are reviewed prior to November 1. First marking period grades **must** be received in order to complete a file before review can be done. Decisions on such applications normally are made within 30 days of receiving them.

Lafayette's Early Decision plan also permits you to apply under regular decision by the January 1 deadline and then switch your application to Early Decision by February 15, if you decide Lafayette is your first choice.

Application Deadline is January 1, 2010.
