

FISHER FIELD OF DREAMS

Press Box

A state-of-the-art press box above the restrooms and concession area will include a VIP suite and ample space for print and electronic media.

Lights

Six lighting standards will feature two levels of lighting—one for recreational, intramurals, football practice, and one for football game conditions. Night games will be enhanced by 100 footcandles of lighting.

New Building

Lafayette's football operations will move into the new football varsity house, scheduled to be opened in 2007. It will house locker rooms, coaches' offices, team meeting rooms, and areas for both sports medicine and strength training.

South Stands

The grandstand on the home side will be enhanced with wider aisles, handrails, and seating, including 488 chairbacks in select sections. With the playing surface lowered and moved closer, site lines will improve dramatically.

Upper Concourse

Fisher Field's upper concourse will feature a new structure that includes restrooms and a concession area. As an added bonus, there will be an arcade effect created by the overhang of the press box above the concourse area.

Lower Concourse

A new lower concourse will be added at the base of the grandstands on the home side of the stadium to handle general foot traffic as well as handicapped seating.

Middle Concourse

The middle concourse will be finished with new lighting, restroom areas, concession areas, and a merchandise stand.

North Stands

The grandstand on the visiting side of the stadium will feature seating for 3,380 and will be greatly enhanced. The old grandstand will be completely torn down and the new one will feature tunnel entryways and raised viewing to enhance site lines.

Recreational Jogging Track

A three-lane recreational jogging track will surround the playing surface.

Field

To enhance spectator site lines, the playing surface is being lowered at least 18 inches and moved approximately 40 feet closer to the grandstand on the home side of the stadium. A state-of-the-art in-fill synthetic surface will be installed both within the stadium and on a 60-yard by 20-yard practice area to the north of the visitors' grandstand.
